House Rules

We're happy to welcome you as guests in our hostel. In order to make your stay at Amstel House as comfortable as possible, we would like to inform you about our policies that affect our mutual consideration.

We expect that the group leaders will be responsible for informing and enforcing these rules with their groups.

To insure the comfort of other guests in the house we have quiet hours between the hours of 10pm and 6am.

The use of radios, CD players as well as musical instruments should be kept at a reasonable volume, and not be heard outside of the room. Should other guests complain about music we will then ask that the instruments or radios be kept at the reception, where they can be picked up again upon departure.

Smoking in the rooms as well as on the floors, as well as having an open flame in the hostel is strictly forbidden due to fire safety codes. The cost of a fire alarm, which involves the fire department, can be expensive, so we ask our guests to please not risk setting off an alarm by smoking in the rooms or on the floors.

The consumption of alcoholic beverages in the hostel is not allowed.

Any damages to the rooms or the house in general must be paid, so that replacements can be purchased.

We don't allow visitors in the rooms who are not guests in our hostel.

Rooms should be locked when nobody is in them. We claim no responsibility for lost or stolen goods.

We ask that food and beverages are not taken from the dining hall.

We ask that you please vacate the rooms before 10:00 on your day of departure.

If these rules are violated we may be forced to ask the group, or the responsible individuals to check out before the intended date of departure.
